Many professionals in the school system work with children and youth who are facing a number of challenging issues. It can feel discouraging and frustrating when efforts to help these students in the school do not seem to be effective. Increasingly, it is recognized that many of these issues are connected to the family, which makes it more difficult to effect change when your role is limited to helping the individual child.

This two-day workshop aims to expand your knowledge and skills in working from a family perspective while working with the individual child or adolescent. Topics include:

- What is a family systems perspective? Why is it important?
- Principles of systems theory and how they are used to understand change and resistance to change
- Major themes of family functioning and dysfunction: family communication, the effect of family history, family rules and roles
- Interventions from a family perspective for school counsellors: assessing for understanding, the role of genograms, using ecomaps to expand the circle of support and intervention

The workshop facilitator is Dr. Linda Burnside, a family therapist with many years of counselling experience from a family systems perspective. Dr. Burnside has worked extensively with children and youth involved with the child welfare system as a result of abuse, neglect, parental substance abuse, parent-teen conflict, and other family issues. She has also been a sessional instructor with the University of Manitoba since 1995.

This workshop is ideal for school counsellors, resource teachers, school teachers, and others who work with children and adolescents and would like to develop a broader perspective on how to help youth who are significantly affected by family issues.
