

Opening mid-morning and closing late afternoon, the Exhibit Hall is expected to attract up to 800 attendees from these sectors:

(Estimated: 30% of attendees.)

From large and small companies alike, they will be exploring ways to better attract and retain employees with disabilities. They will be on the lookout for suppliers who can effectively supply applicants to meet their hiring needs. They will be seeking expertise and accommodations needed to help them retain valued employees who are acquiring disabilities. (Estimated: 10% of attendees.)
